

Chapter 51: SEWER SYSTEM

Section

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51.01 ADOPTION OF SEWER USE ORDINANCE BY REFERENCE

Ord., passed May 5, 1982, and entitled "An Ordinance to regulate, restrict, and limit, in the interest of public health and safety, the deposit or discharge of certain substances into any sanitary sewer owned and maintained by the Town of Faison, and providing penalties for violations thereof; in or out of the Town of Faison, County of Duplin, State of North Carolina" is hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this code of Ordinances as if fully set forth herein. Copies of said ordinance are available at the Town Hall office for public inspection during regular business hours.

51.02 SEWER HOOK-UPS

- (A) All owners and/or occupants are required to hook-up to the town sewer system when available and pay any hook-up fee as may be established by the Town Board of Commissioners from time to time.
- (B) The Town may reject any application for services not available under a standard rate, which involves excessive service cost, or for other good and sufficient reasons; in which case the consumer's deposit will be refunded.

51.03 SEWER RATES

- (A) Sewer rates shall be in the amount as established by the Town Board of Commissioners from time to time.
- (B) For more than one unit on one meter and also out of town users, each unit, business, or family shall be charged separately for sewer service. (Ord., passed 5-14-84; Ord., passed 10-3-84)

51.04 CONSUMER'S RESPONSIBILITY

To avoid the infiltration of surface water into the Town's wastewater treatment system, it shall be the responsibility of the consumer and/or the property owner to eliminate or otherwise repair defective sewer lines are discovered on consumer's premises by representatives of the Town, it shall be the responsibility of the Town to notify the property owner by certified mail, advising the property owner of the discovered problem and advising the property owner that such problem must be corrected within fifteen (15) days. Should the property owner refuse or otherwise fail to correct said defective lines within the fifteen (15) day period allowed, the Town will disconnect both the water and sewer service provided to the premises.(Ord., passed 9-4-91),(Adopted 9-5-07)
